I PRAISE YOU Lord, that You've called us to be the repairer of the breach. But how can we stand strong on behalf of others when we have so many breaches in our own lives? Please teach us, through Your Word, how to become spiritually fortified so we can stand strong on behalf of others that are in spiritual need!

I PRAISE YOU Lord, that while You've told us to, "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith" (2. Cor. 13:5), You've also called us to Your side for healing! You've poured out all heaven in one gift– JESUS! And He would have come to earth just for me!

Breaches – 2A

I PRAISE YOU Lord, that You come to bring us abundant life. You come to bring joy, health, purity, spiritual success, and victory. Help me to recognize that it is devil who brings death, erosion of strength, destruction, disease, loss of hope, doubt, and despair.

I PRAISE YOU Lord, that You are the Father of Light, not the father of lies. You are merciful, long-suffering, gentle, our rescuer and deliver. You wisper hope to our soul, not discouragement and doubt! Help us to not be decieved by the voice of the enemy!

I PRAISE YOU Lord, that You come to deliver us from the power of the enemy! I praise You that we do not have to be overcome. Help us know how to move forward in faith no matter what we face!

I PRAISE YOU Lord, that You are a God of mercy, love, and healing, not abuse. While you chasten us, You cut to heal, not to hurt, to make whole, not to destroy. Please forgive me for the times I've accused You of the pain, havoc, cruelty lies, abuse, and threats that come from the enemy!

I PRAISE YOU Lord, that You are our loving Bridegroom, not a harsh taskmaster or husband. Please help me to recognize that You are patient, tender, a rescuer of the weak. It is the enemy who is impatient, cold, harsh, demanding, distant, controlling, verbally and physically abuse.

I PRAISE YOU Lord, that You are our loving Shepherd versus the roaring lion that is seeking to devour us. You never tire of taking care of us. You never tire of looking out for our needs. Forgive me for sometimes thinking that the spiritual attacks I receive are from You!

I PRAISE YOU Lord, that You have power to break down every rival, every idol, every foothold of the enemy in my life! Teach me how to fall on the Rock Christ Jesus. Teach me how to be broken that there will be no more breaches in my heart that hold me back from You!
