"However trifling this or that wrong act may seem in the eyes of men, no sin is small in the sight of God. Man's judgment is partial, imperfect, but God estimates all things as they really are. But these are sins that are especially offensive to God, for they are contrary to the benevolence of His character, to that unselfish love which is the very atmosphere of the unfallen universe... ...He who falls into some of the grosser sins may feel a sense of his shame and poverty and his need of the grace of Christ;

but pride feels no need, and so it closes the heart against Christ and the infinite blessings He came to give."
